Bernadette:

- Advised there were 6 town signs where we thought there were only 5 and the borough administrator needs the wording for the 6th sign (which we will place at the entrance to Leonia coming from Teaneck on Fort Lee Road). It was suggested that Harriet at the Library may be able to locate the missing language, and that it might also be in the Leonia Bi-centennial book.
