Public Portion: Ann Marie Krim from 188 Highwood asking for trees to be planted in right of way – resident does not want a shade tree on private property. - 4. Electric vehicles possible ordinance. Sites will potentially be Beechwood parkin and police station parking.

Chairperson Report:

- Lanternfly: Imanta would like to put information regarding the SLF infestation education on how to manage egg nests, insecticide, tree of heaven removal.
- Andrea/DPW will send out informational flyer referencing boro website and information on SLF. Discussion to waive fee for removal of tree of heaven –
- Mike Grecco and Cathy will meet to update the shade tree portion of our website.
- Private Property Planting addresses: Christine and Imanta need addresses by end of Aug.
- Ash trees in the Hills Chuck suggested that removal and replant is better than pruning. Chuck will measure to see which trees are in the right of way. Julie will compose a letter to the

homeowner with ash trees in the town right of way stating that the tree is on town property and will be removed. We will replant.

- 312 Magnolia in need of removal to prepare for Fall planting.
- 325 Magnolia resident is asking to relocate cherry tree. Imanta is checking in on the matter.
- To assess ash trees at Station Parkway. 101, 103, 105 Station Parkway have ash trees that need removal. Once they are assessed, DPW will remove.
- Residents at Broad Ave between Park and Highwood were approached to receive private plantings but no residents expressed interest or reached out to STC.
