

**ORDINANCE NO. 2019-10
BOROUGH OF LEONIA
COUNTY OF BERGEN**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 194
ENTITLED “VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC” §194-8 “HANDICAPPED PARKING
AREAS” ARTICLE XIV “SCHEDULE V: HANDICAPPED PARKING” OF THE
CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF LEONIA**

WHEREAS, §194-8 “Handicapped Parking Areas” of the Code of the Borough of Leonia allows for handicapped parking spaces within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, Schedule V: Handicapped Parking of the Code of the Borough of Leonia lists the locations of handicapped parking within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, there are currently two handicap spaces at the Senior Building/Little House located at 305 Beechwood Place, and a request has been made to add a third handicap parking space at this location; and

WHEREAS, a request has been made to add a handicap parking space by Anna C. Scott Elementary School on Broad Avenue, at the first parking space 35 feet north of Crescent Avenue on the east side of Broad Avenue; and

WHEREAS, a personal handicap parking space has been requested by Richard J. Samperi for a parking space near 115 High Street, after providing the appropriate handicap credentials.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Leonia, as follows:

Section 1.

Chapter 194 “Vehicles and Traffic” §194-8 “Handicapped Parking Areas” Article XIV “Schedule V: Handicapped Parking” is hereby amended to add the following locations as designated handicapped parking spaces:

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.


Section 4. Effect.
