Chairperson's Report:

Jane discussed the removal of a shade tree on Oakdene, without prior permission. We discussed whether or not to send the contractor a bill to pay a fee for an illegal removal.

Jane has sent in our budget with the Tree City application.

We have \$2,000 in the trust fund for new plantings. Meghan and Anne will research where to do the new plantings.

Leonia Day is in the works. The date is May 17, 1-5 pm.

Commissioner's Reports:

Kate discussed the need to educate the public about the destructive Emerald Ash Borer, which is making its way towards us. It is estimated that the cost of removing and replacing Ash trees infected by the EAB in the United States will run \$10 billion! We discussed different approaches but agreed that people need to be proactive, be able to identify their Ash trees, and set traps for the borers. We will need to take an inventory of town Ash trees, but cannot do this until the spring, when they start to leaf out.

The town has not planted Ashes in Leonia since 2007.
