The Borough of Leonia is launching its

Grand Avenue Redevelopment Plan to spur
redevelopment that will enhance and preserve
the character of Leonia. The Grand Avenue
Redevelopment Plan will provide a framework and
regulations for future development of the Grand
Avenue Redevelopment Area.

What is a Redevelopment Plan?

A Redevelopment Plan is an effective tool for a municipality to guide and control future development in a redevelopment area. It serves as a comprehensive approach to planning issues and considers many factors impacting a community's economic development needs.

The Redevelopment Plan gives the municipality the legal basis for control over future development. This change acts as an update to the zoning ordinance that is intended to shape development in a way that is in the best interests of the Borough.

The Borough of Leonia in 2015 designated the area west of Grand Avenue between Leonia High School and Station Parkway as an Area in Need of Rehabilitation with a smaller area generally around Fort Lee Road as an Area in Need of Redevelopment. The Redevelopment Plan is expected to be completed by Spring 2023.
