Councilman Knott explained that he had spoken to Fire Marshal Haenelt in regards to the additional fire hydrant that will be placed on Fort Lee Road by the Over Peck Park entrance. Apparently Fire Marshal Haenelt feels we should take advantage of the work being done by the County to Over Peck Park which would make it easier to get the hydrant installed at no cost to the Borough. Administrator Terhune confirmed that the Borough would not have to pay to install the hydrant that they will only be expected to pay for the annual maintenance as they do with other hydrants within the Borough.

Councilman Hawkins added that there are actually two (2) hydrants being installed but as Councilman Knott pointed out only one was mentioned in this resolution. Administrator Terhune explained that only one is being installed for the Borough and the other hydrant that Council Hawkins made reference to is closer to the new traffic circle which the county would be responsible for, which was part of the original plan.

Councilman Whitter wanted to clarify that the fire hydrant would be west of the railroad tracks, and also asked who actually maintains the hydrants? Councilman Hawkins answered that United Water maintains all fire hydrants in the Borough.
