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2012 RESOLUTION BUDGET

RES-2012-167: Authorizing Estimated Tax Bills

WHEREAS, the Borough of Leonia adopted its budget on April 2, 2012, but the Bergen County Board of Taxation has been unable to certify Leonia's tax rate as of the current date, and the Borough's Tax Collector will be unable to mail the Borough's 2012 tax bills by June 14th, and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Leonia Tax Collector has computed an estimated tax levy in accordance with N.J.S.A. 54:4-66.3, and he has signed a certification showing the tax levies for the previous year, the tax rate, and the range of permitted estimated tax levies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Governing Body of the Borough of Leonia, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey on this 11th day of June 2012 as follows:

- The Leonia Tax Collector is hereby authorized and directed to prepare and issue estimated tax bills for the Borough of Leonia for the Third Installment of 2012.
 The Tax Collector shall take such actions as are permitted and required by P.L. 1994, c.72 (N.J.S.A. 54:4-66.2 and 54:4-66.3).
- 2. The entire estimated tax levy for the third quarter of 2012 is hereby set at \$33,667,619.52.
- 3. In accordance with the law the Third Installment of 2012 taxes shall not be subject to interest until the later of August 10th or the twenty-fifth day after the date the estimated tax bills are mailed. The estimated tax bills shall contain a notice specifying the date on which interest may begin to accrue.

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2012 ORDINANCE GENERAL

ORD-2012-43. Merger of Planning Board and Zoning Board AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A A JOINT PLANNING BOARD/ZONING BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT AND AMENDING CHAPTER 37 ENTITLED "LAND USE PROCEDURES" OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF LEONIA COUNTY OF BERGEN

AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Leonia, that Chapter 37 entitled "Land Use Procedures" of the Ordinances of the Borough of Leonia is hereby amended so as to consolidate all powers, duties, authority and jurisdiction of the Board of Adjustment of the Borough of Leonia with those of the Planning Board of the Borough of Leonia and granting the same to the latter pursuant to and in accordance with N.J. S.A. 40:55D45 in order that it act as the sole municipal land use board of the borough and further amending and supplementing related provisions of the code to effectuate the said transition and that those portions of the aforesaid set forth below are hereby amended as follows and that portions of the Ordinance not set forth below shall remain unchanged:

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40:55D-25 (c) authorizes municipalities having a population of 15,000 or less to establish by Ordinance, a single nine-member Planning Board to exercise all the powers of the Planning Board and Board of Adjustment; and

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WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council find that the Borough of Leonia has a population of less than 15,000, and that the adoption of an Ordinance establishing a joint Planning and Zoning Board is in the best interest of the Borough;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Leonia in the County of Bergen and State of New Jersey as follows:

ARTICLE I

PLANNING BOARD

Article I, entitled Planning Board, §37-1 through §37-8 is hereby deleted in its entirety.

ARTICLE II

BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT

Article II, entitled Board of Adjustment, §37-9 through §37-18 is hereby deleted in its entirety.

ARTICLE III PROVISIONS APPLICABLE TO PLANNING BOARD AND BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT

Section 1. §37-19 titled "Provisions Applicable to Planning Board and Board of Adjustment" shall be renumbered as Article I, §37-1 through §37-9.

Section 2. All references to the Zoning Board of Adjustment in Article III shall be deleted.

ARTICLE IV

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APPEALS

Section 1. §37-28 titled "Appeals" shall be renumbered as Article II, §37-10 through §37-11 and amended to read as follows:

An appeal to the Planning Board may be taken by any interested party affected by any decision of the Construction Official of the municipality based on or made in the enforcement of the Zoning Ordinance or official Map. Such appeal shall be taken within sixty-five (65) days in accordance with the provisions of Article 9 of the Municipal Land Use Law of 1975.

ARTICLE V

FEES

Section 1. §37-30 titled "Fees" shall be renumbered as Article III, §37-12 through §37-12.

ARTICLE VI

FEES

Section 1. $\S37-32$ titled "General Provisions shall be renumbered as Article IV, $\S37-14$ through $\S37-17$.

REPEALER

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are repealed as to such inconsistencies.

SEVERABILITY

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
