### § 267-11G.

In the event that the Leonia Police Department requires a vehicle to be impounded for possible evidentiary value, the licensed tow operator agrees that said tow shall be at no cost to the Borough of Leonia, provided that the vehicle is towed to a location within Bergen County.

### BOROUGH OF LEONIA ORDINANCE 15-11

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND Chapter 197 of the Code of the Borough of Leonia titled "Parks" by adding a new section, to be designated as Ordinance 197-13, titled "Fees and Policies for the Use of Leonia Parks."

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Leonia, County of Bergen and State of New Jersey as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> Ordinance 197 of the Code of the Borough of Leonia, titled "Parks" is hereby amended by adding a new section, to be designated as Ordinance 197-13, titled "Fees and Policies for the Use of Leonia Parks" as follows:

### § 197-13A - Fees and Policies for the Use of Leonia Parks (except Sylvan Park)

The following is the policy of the Leonia Recreation Commission concerning the use of any Park in Leonia, other than Sylvan Park, by all groups or organizations that are not under the direct supervision of the Leonia Recreation Department.

- 1. Any group or organization wishing to use a park must be granted a permit from the Leonia Recreation Department prior to the event.
- 2. Any group or organization requesting the use of a Park will be required to pay the following fees prior to the event or activity:

A. Leonia resident fee  $$100.00\ {\rm for\ a\ three}$$  hour time limit.

Non resident fee \$200.00 for a three hour time limit.

The Leonia Recreation Commission and/or staff reserve the right to adjust aforementioned fees, as they deem appropriate: However, they may not increase fees according to those stated above.

3. This policy allows the waiving or reducing of above fees to any Leonia group recognized as a non-profit organization, if it is the desire of the Leonia Recreation Commission.

### § 197-13B. - Fees and Policies for the Use of Sylvan Park.

The following is the policy of the Leonia Recreation Commission concerning the use of Sylvan Park by all groups or organizations that are not under the direct supervision of the Leonia Recreation Department.

- 1. Any group or organization wishing to use Sylvan Park must be granted a permit from the Leonia Recreation Department prior to the event.
- 2. Any group requesting the use of Sylvan Park must provide a proper Certificate of Insurance and Hold Harmless Agreement
- 3. Any group or organization requesting the use of Sylvan Park will be required to pay the following fees prior to the event or activity:
  - A. September 1st through November 30th & March 1st through June 30th \$1,792.00 per week OR \$256.00 per day, per field.
  - B. July 1st through August 31st & December 1st through February 28th (29th) \$826.00 per week OR \$118.00 per day, per field.
- 4. The above rates apply to Leonia residents and their affiliates. Out of town groups or organizations will have additional fees applied, up to double of the above rates.
- 5. The Leonia Recreation Commission and/or staff reserve the right to adjust aforementioned fees, as they deem appropriate: However, they may not increase fees according to those stated above.
- 6. This policy allows the waiving (or reducing??) of above fees to any Leonia group recognized as a non-profit organization, if it is the desire of the Leonia Recreation Commission.
- 7. The use of the park lighting system will be used no earlier than  $5:00\ PM$  and must be turned off, on or before  $10:00\ PM$ .

<u>Section 2.</u> If any part of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Ordinance.

 $\underline{\text{Section 3}}$ . All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended to the extent of such inconsistency.

 $\underline{\underline{\textbf{Section}}\ \underline{\textbf{4}}}.$  This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to law.
