BOROUGH OF LEONIA ORDINANCE 16-11

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING Chapter 66 titled "Volunteer Services" to add a new section regarding Volunteer Emergency Standby Guidelines.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Leonia as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Code of the Borough of Leonia is hereby amended by adding a new section to be known as 66-18 as follows:

66-18 Volunteer Emergency Standby Guidelines

- 1. The Office of Emergency Management Coordinator is responsible for notifying and coordinating with the Mayor, Borough Administrator, Fire Department of circumstances which indicate a potential need for volunteer standby personnel. Said notification shall be made as soon as possible in order to provide the maximum time for response.
- 2. The Chief of the Fire Department shall request approval of all standby time for monetary compensation from the Borough Administrator. Any request for standby time shall include both a specific start time as well as a specific end time if known. If the extent of the requested standby time is not known when the request is made, a request for the specific number of hours of standby time shall be requested. If any request pursuant to this ordinance is denied by the Administrator or the Administrator is not available, the Mayor shall have the authority to approve standby time.
- 3. Standby time must be approved by the Borough Administrator or Mayor as set forth in paragraph 2 above in order for it to be compensable by the Borough.
- 4. After taking action on any request for standby time, the Borough Administrator shall notify the Mayor, council liaison, and Volunteer Fire Department if standby duty has been approved and the hours that have been approved. If the Mayor shall approve standby time, the Administrator, council liaison, and Volunteer Fire Department Chief shall be notified.
- 5. Unless otherwise determined by the Borough Administrator or Mayor, as set forth in paragraph 2 above, standby time approval shall normally include a total of six (6) firefighters.
- 6. Any increase in standby personnel must be approved in advance by the Borough Administrator or Mayor as set forth in paragraph 2 above.
- 7. In the event that that Borough Administrator or Mayor, as set forth in paragraph 2 above, approves standby time without a specific ending time, the Volunteer

Fire Department Chief shall keep the Borough Administrator, Mayor and council liaisons informed of the conditions that created the need for standby time and will, as soon as possible, advise them of when standby time can be terminated.

- 8. Upon determining that standby time will no longer be necessary, the Borough Administrator or Mayor, as set forth in paragraph 2 above, shall notify the Volunteer Fire Department Chief of the specific time that standby service shall be terminated. The Borough Administrator shall also inform the Mayor and council liaisons of the termination of standby time.
- <u>Section 2.</u> If any part of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Ordinance.

<u>Section 3</u>. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to law.

BOROUGH OF LEONIA ORDINANCE 17-11

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING Chapter 190 of the Code of the Borough of Leonia titled "Parking, off-street."

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Leonia as follows:

Section 1. The Code of the Borough of Leonia is hereby amended by amending §190-1, §190-4, adding a new §190-8 to be titled "Borough Hall annex parking area" and renumbering existing §190-8 through §190-11.

Ordinance 190-1 titled "Definitions" is hereby amended by adding the following definition:

BOROUGH HALL ANNEX AREA

Includes the area owned by the Borough of Leonia situated at the southeast corner of the intersection of Broad Avenue and Beechwood Place.

Section 2.

Ordinance 190-4 is amended to read as follows:

§190-1 - Definitions.

Includes the area owned by the Borough of Leonia situated at the southeast corner of the intersection of Broad Avenue and Beechwood Place.

Section 3.

A new Ordinance 190-8 shall be included to read as follows:

§190-4 - Parking time limited; exceptions.

A. With the exception of the Library Parking Area and the provisions of $\S190$ -6, $\S190$ -7, $\S190$ -8 and Subsection B below, it is unlawful for any person to cause, allow or permit any motor vehicle, other than a motor vehicle displaying a sticker or permit as provided and prescribed in $\S190$ -8 of this article, to stand or be parked in any parking area or space for more than three hours on any day exclusive of Sunday. Within the "Library Parking Area," as defined in $\S190$ -1 above, the foregoing three-hour restriction shall apply during library operating hours only, seven days per week.

Section 4.

§190-8 Borough Hall annex parking area.

A new section 190-8 shall be included to read as follows:

- A. Parking shall be permitted in the Borough Hall annex parking area in designated spaces.
- B. Between 12:01 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., there shall be no fee for parking in the Borough Hall annex parking area. Between 6:01 a.m. and 12:00 a.m., there shall be a parking charge of \$0.50 per hour with a maximum time limit of two (2) hours at a rate of \$1.00.
- C. It shall be unlawful for any person to cause, allow or permit any motor vehicle to park other than completely in a designated space.

Section 5.

Existing ordinance 190-8 titled "Parking permits and stickers" shall be renumbered as Ordinance 190-9, Ordinance 190-9 titled "Vehicle weight limit" shall be renumbered as Ordinance 190-10, Ordinance 190-10 titled "Liability for loss, damage or injury" shall be renumbered as Ordinance 190-11 and Ordinance 190-11 titled "Violations and penalties" shall be renumbered as Ordinance 190-12.

<u>Section 6.</u> If any part of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Ordinance.

<u>Section 7</u>. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 8. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to law.
