<u>Section 1.</u> The Code of the Borough of Leonia is hereby amended by deleting and repealing Ordinance 49-4, "Table of Organization".

<u>Section 2</u>. The Code of the Borough of Leonia is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section, to replace Ordinance 49-4 hereinabove repealed, to read as follows:

49-4. Table of Organization.

- A. The Police Department shall consist of the following positions: One Chief of Police, one Lieutenant, four Sergeants, and eleven officers.
- <u>Section 3</u>. The position of part time traffic officer is defined as the officer who will be responsible for enforcing the laws of the Borough and parking restrictions along Broad Avenue and in the Municipal Parking lots. The Salary for said officer will be consistent with the current Salary Ordinance, Section 3 "Police Department" A. Non Union Personnel at a salary from \$15.00 to 20.00 an hour with no benefits.
- <u>Section 4</u>. If any part of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Ordinance.
- <u>Section 5</u>. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended to the extent of such inconsistency.

<u>Section 6</u>. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to law.
