2023 BOROUGH PROCLAMATION DECLARING THE FIRST FRIDAY IN JUNE TO BE NATIONAL GUN VIOLENCE AWARENESS DAY

This proclamation declares the first Friday in June to be National Gun Violence Awareness Day in the Borough of Leonia to honor and remember all victims and survivors of gun violence and to declare that we as a country must do more to end this public health crisis.

WHEREAS, every day, more than 120 Americans are killed by gun violence and more than 200 are shot and wounded, with an average of more than 17,000 gun homicides every year; and

WHEREAS, Americans are 26 times more likely to die by gun homicide than people in other high-income countries; and

WHEREAS, New Jersey has 427 gun deaths every year, with a rate of 4.8 deaths per 100,000 people, a crisis that costs the state \$5.3 billion each year, of which \$168.9 million is paid by taxpayers. New Jersey has the 5th lowest rate of gun deaths in the US; and

WHEREAS, gun homicides and assaults are concentrated in cities, with more than half of all firearm related gun deaths in the nation occurring in 127 cities; and

WHEREAS, cities across the nation, including in Leonia, are working to end the senseless violence with evidence-based solutions; and

WHEREAS, protecting public safety in the communities they serve is mayors' highest responsibility; and

WHEREAS, support for the Second Amendment rights of law-abiding citizens goes hand-in-hand with keeping guns away from people with dangerous histories; and

WHEREAS, mayors and law enforcement officers —in partnership with local violence intervention activists and resources —know their communities best, are the most familiar with local criminal activity and how to address it, and are best positioned to understand how to keep their citizens safe; and

WHEREAS, gun violence prevention is more important than ever as we see an increase in firearm homicides, and nonfatal shootings across the country, increased calls to domestic violence hotlines, and an increase in city gun violence;

WHEREAS, in January 2013, Hadiya Pendleton was tragically shot and killed at age 15; and on June 2, 2023 to recognize the 26th birthday of Hadiya Pendleton (born: June 2, 1997), people across the United States will recognize National Gun Violence Awareness Day and wear orange in tribute to -

- (1) Hadiya Pendleton and other victims of gun violence; and
- (2) the loved ones of those victims; and

WHEREAS, the idea was inspired by a group of Hadiya's friends, who asked their classmates to commemorate her life by wearing orange; they chose this color because hunters wear orange to announce themselves to other hunters when out in the woods, and orange is a color that symbolizes the value of human life; and

WHEREAS, anyone can join this campaign by pledging to wear orange on June 2nd, the first Friday in June in 2023, to help raise awareness about gun violence; and

WHEREAS, by wearing orange on June 2, 2023 Americans will raise awareness about gun violence and honor the lives of gun violence victims and survivors; and

WHEREAS, we renew our commitment to reduce gun violence and pledge to do all we can to keep firearms out of the hands of people who should not have access to them, and encourage responsible gun ownership to help keep our families and communities safe.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Mayor Zeigler of the Borough of Leonia declares the first Friday in June, June 2, 2023, to be National Gun Violence Awareness Day. I encourage all citizens to support their local communities' efforts to prevent the tragic effects of gun violence and to honor and value human lives.

BOROUGH OF LEONIA ORDINANCE NO. 2023-07

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 181 ENTITLED "NOISE", ARTICLE II ENTITLED "TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT, SECTION 10 ENTITLED "RESTRICTIONS ON USE OF TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT" OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF LEONIA TO PROVIDE FOR RESTRICTIONS ON THE USE OF INTERNAL COMBUSTION LEAF BLOWERS TO CORRECT THE DESIGNATION OF THE SECTION NUMBERS IN THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF LEONIA

WHEREAS excessive sound is a serious hazard to the public health, welfare, safety, and the quality of life; and

WHEREAS a substantial body of science and technology exists by which excessive sound may be substantially abated; and

WHEREAS the people have a right to, and should be ensured of, an environment free from excessive sound,

NOW, THEREFORE, it is the policy of the Borough of Leonia to prevent excessive sound that may jeopardize the health, welfare, or safety of the citizens or degrade the quality of life.

This ordinance shall apply to the control of sound originating from sources within the Borough of Leonia.

Be it ordained that Chapter 181, Article II, Section 181-13 of the Code of the Borough of Leonia is hereby amended and supplemented by the addition of the following:

Section 1.

181-13H Internal Combustion Leafblowers

- 1. Purpose and Intent. The Borough of Leonia hereby finds that unlimited use of leafblowers powered by internal combustion engines impairs the economic and social welfare, health, peace and quality of life of persons residing in Leonia. The purpose of this section is to minimize the adverse impact of such equipment by restricting its use within the Borough.
- 2. Hours of Use. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this chapter, leafblowers powered by internal combustion engines shall not be operated in the Borough of Leonia except as follows:
 - (A) On weekdays between 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., except that leafblowers may be used by an occupant or owner of the premises between 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. on weekdays.
 - (B) On Saturdays between 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m., except that leafblowers may be used by an occupant or owner of the premises between 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

- (C) On Sundays use is prohibited except that leafblowers may be used by an occupant or owner of the property between 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.
- 3. Limitation on Use of Leafblowers Powered by Internal Combustion Engines. The operation of leafblowers powered by internal combustion engines shall be limited to each calendar year to the time period between March 15 and May 15, inclusive and between October 15 and December 15 inclusive. The Municipal Emergency Management Coordinator, Deputy Municipal Emergency Management Coordinator shall have the authority to extend or modify such dates when extreme or unusual weather conditions warrant.
- 4. Mufflers. It shall be a violation hereof to operate any leafblower powered by an internal combustion engine in the Borough of Leonia without a properly functioning muffler.
- 5. Safety Equipment. Business operators shall provide their employees using leafblowers powered by internal combustion engines with appropriate equipment to protect employees' health, including hearing protection and eye protection. Business operators shall further ensure that employees use appropriate personal protective equipment while operating leaf blowers powered by internal combustion engines.
- 6. Responsibilities of Property Owners, Business Operators, Landlords and Tenants. Property owners, business operators, landlords and tenants of a property shall each have all the duties and responsibilities prescribed in this chapter, and no property owner, business operator, landlord or tenant shall be relieved from such duties or responsibilities by reason of the fact that the other of them or the occupant is also responsible therefor and in violation thereof.
- 7. Emergencies. The Municipal Emergency Management Coordinator, Deputy Municipal Emergency Management Coordination and Second Deputy Municipal Emergency Management Coordinator are authorized to suspend any one or more of the provision of this section for a period of 24 hours or more whenever such Coordinator determines that an emergency situation exists in the Borough. Such suspension may be renewed each day during the continuance of such emergency.

Section 2.

Consistency

If any provision or portion of a provision of this ordinance is held to be unconstitutional, preempted by Federal or State law or otherwise invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of the ordinance shall not be invalidated.

Section 3.

Severability

If ay article, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason deemed to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 4.

Repealer

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5.

Effect

This ordinance will take effect immediately upon publication.

AUTHORIZE BID FOR LEASE OF BOROUGH-OWNED PROPERTY FOR LEAF COMPOSTING FACILITY – BLOCK 102, LOT 3

WHEREAS, the Borough of Leonia is the owner of property designated as Block 102, Lot 3 on the Tax Map of the Borough of Leonia; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough have approved a lease for the use of a portion of the aforesaid property for the purpose of operating a leaf composting facility for a five (5) year term; and

WHEREAS, the term of the aforesaid lease ends on June 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Borough wishes to lease the aforesaid property on a non-exclusive basis, with new terms and conditions; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:12-14 sets forth, in relevant part, that a municipality may lease any real property not needed for public use; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Leonia seeks to support not-for-profit service charities like the Leonia Sports Boosters which have demonstrated a commitment to the betterment of the community; and

WHEREAS, the Leonia Sports Boosters have requested to use the Borough-owned facility known as the Borough of Leonia Swim Club Pool located on Grand Avenue, for the purposes of hosting a charitable fundraiser dinner dance event to be held on June 3, 2023 from 7 PM to 11:00 PM; and

WHEREAS, the Leonia Sports Boosters, intend to permit the public attending this event to possess or consume alcoholic beverages at the above-referenced facility; and

WHEREAS, Borough Ordinance 80-5 entitled "Consumption in Public Prohibited" forbids the consumption of alcoholic beverages in Borough facilities; and

WHEREAS, Borough Ordinance 80-5 specifically prohibits and anticipates that exceptions to the prohibition may be in the public interest when it refers to the exception codified as Borough Ordinance 80-7; and

WHEREAS, the Borough believes the application submitted by the Leonia Sports Boosters is consistent with the important public policy served by the above referenced exception provision.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Leonia, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey hereby approves the request of the Leonia Sports Boosters to permit the consumption of alcohol at the Leonia Swim Club pool, located at Grand Avenue.
