BOROUGH OF LEONIA ORDINANCE NO. 2023-07

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 181 ENTITLED "NOISE", ARTICLE II ENTITLED "TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT, SECTION 10 ENTITLED "RESTRICTIONS ON USE OF TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT" OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF LEONIA TO PROVIDE FOR RESTRICTIONS ON THE USE OF INTERNAL COMBUSTION LEAF BLOWERS TO CORRECT THE DESIGNATION OF THE SECTION NUMBERS IN THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF LEONIA

WHEREAS excessive sound is a serious hazard to the public health, welfare, safety, and the quality of life; and

WHEREAS a substantial body of science and technology exists by which excessive sound may be substantially abated; and

WHEREAS the people have a right to, and should be ensured of, an environment free from excessive sound,

NOW, THEREFORE, it is the policy of the Borough of Leonia to prevent excessive sound that may jeopardize the health, welfare, or safety of the citizens or degrade the quality of life.

This ordinance shall apply to the control of sound originating from sources within the Borough of Leonia.

Be it ordained that Chapter 181, Article II, Section 181-13 of the Code of the Borough of Leonia is hereby amended and supplemented by the addition of the following:

Section 1.

181-13H Internal Combustion Leafblowers

- 1. Purpose and Intent. The Borough of Leonia hereby finds that unlimited use of leafblowers powered by internal combustion engines impairs the economic and social welfare, health, peace and quality of life of persons residing in Leonia. The purpose of this section is to minimize the adverse impact of such equipment by restricting its use within the Borough.
- 2. Hours of Use. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this chapter, leafblowers powered by internal combustion engines shall not be operated in the Borough of Leonia except as follows:
 - (A) On weekdays between 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., except that leafblowers may be used by an occupant or owner of the premises between 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. on weekdays.
 - (B) On Saturdays between 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m., except that leafblowers may be used by an occupant or owner of the premises between 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

- (C) On Sundays use is prohibited except that leafblowers may be used by an occupant or owner of the property between 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.
- 3. Limitation on Use of Leafblowers Powered by Internal Combustion Engines. The operation of leafblowers powered by internal combustion engines shall be limited to each calendar year to the time period between March 15 and May 15, inclusive and between October 15 and December 15 inclusive. The Municipal Emergency Management Coordinator, Deputy Municipal Emergency Management Coordinator shall have the authority to extend or modify such dates when extreme or unusual weather conditions warrant.
- 4. Mufflers. It shall be a violation hereof to operate any leafblower powered by an internal combustion engine in the Borough of Leonia without a properly functioning muffler.
- 5. Safety Equipment. Business operators shall provide their employees using leafblowers powered by internal combustion engines with appropriate equipment to protect employees' health, including hearing protection and eye protection. Business operators shall further ensure that employees use appropriate personal protective equipment while operating leaf blowers powered by internal combustion engines.
- 6. Responsibilities of Property Owners, Business Operators, Landlords and Tenants. Property owners, business operators, landlords and tenants of a property shall each have all the duties and responsibilities prescribed in this chapter, and no property owner, business operator, landlord or tenant shall be relieved from such duties or responsibilities by reason of the fact that the other of them or the occupant is also responsible therefor and in violation thereof.
- 7. Emergencies. The Municipal Emergency Management Coordinator, Deputy Municipal Emergency Management Coordination and Second Deputy Municipal Emergency Management Coordinator are authorized to suspend any one or more of the provision of this section for a period of 24 hours or more whenever such Coordinator determines that an emergency situation exists in the Borough. Such suspension may be renewed each day during the continuance of such emergency.

Section 2.

Consistency

If any provision or portion of a provision of this ordinance is held to be unconstitutional, preempted by Federal or State law or otherwise invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of the ordinance shall not be invalidated.

Section 3.

Severability

If ay article, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason deemed to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 4.

Repealer

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5.

Effect

This ordinance will take effect immediately upon publication.

BOROUGH OF LEONIA ORDINANCE # 2023-08

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING USAGE FEES FOR PUBLICLY-ACCESSIBLE MUNICIPAL ELECTRIC VEHICLE SUPPLY/SERVICE EQUIPMENT (EVSE)

WHEREAS, the Borough established procedures and standards for the installation and use of Electric Vehicle Supply/Service Equipment ("EVSE") and Make-Ready parking spaces within the Borough of Leonia, County of Bergen; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to encourage use of publicly-accessible municipal EVSE the Borough of Leonia desires to modify the usage fees for publicly-accessible municipal EVSE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Leonia, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. The Code of the Borough of Leonia, Chapter 290, Section 60.1 entitled "Electric Vehicle Supply/Service Equipment" be and is hereby amended. Any additions are indicated by **between asterisks and/or in bold** and deletions are indicated by {within brackets and/or struck through}.

§ 290-60.1 Electric Vehicle Supply/Service Equipment

- F. Reasonable Standards for All New EVSE and Make-Ready Parking Spaces

 - a. For publicly-accessible municipal EVSE: In addition to any parking fees, the fee to use parking spaces within the municipality identified as EVSE spaces shall be as follows for each hour that the electric vehicle is connected to the publicly-accessible municipal EVSE:

Time	Hourly Rate/Violation
1st hour	\$5 (minimum fee)
2nd hour	\$5
3rd hour	\$8

4th hour (maximum time limit)	{ \$16 } ** \$8 **
After 4 hours	\$50 violation
Parked without charging	\$100 violation

- b. These fees may be amended by a resolution adopted by the governing body.
- c. Private EVSE: Nothing in this ordinance shall be deemed to preclude a private owner/designee of an EVSE from collecting a fee for the use of the EVSE, in accordance with applicable State and Federal regulations. Fees shall be available on the EVSE or posted at or adjacent to the EVSE parking space.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

Section 3. Repeal of Prior Ordinances. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication as provided by law.

BOROUGH OF LEONIA ORDINANCE # 2023-09

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER 223 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF LEONIA ENTITLED "RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING", SECTION 223-1 ENTITLED "PARKING RESTRICTIONS".

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Leonia has determined that there was an oversight in Chapter 223 of the Code of the Borough of Leonia entitled "Residential Permit Parking", Section 223-1 entitled "Parking Restrictions" which restricted parking on Broad Avenue and within the central business district on Saturdays and Sundays between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. preventing individuals from easy access to local businesses.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Leonia, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1.

Chapter 223 of the Code of the Borough of Leonia, "Residential Permit Parking", Section 223-1 "Parking Restrictions", be and is hereby amended with the additional of Paragraph E as follows:

223-1 Parking Restrictions

E. Broad Avenue from Harrison Street to Crescent Avenue and Hillside Avenue from Broad Avenue to a point 150 feet to the west of Broad Avenue are exempted from the restrictions set forth in Section 223-1A, B, C and D.

Section 2.

All other provisions of Chapter 223 of the Code of the Borough of Leonia, "Residential Permit Parking", of the Code of the Borough of Leonia are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. Severability

If any article, section, sub-section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is, for any reason, deemed to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

AUTHORIZATION TO APPLY FOR THE BERGEN COUNTY OPEN SPACE GRANT APPLICATION

WHEREAS, the Bergen County Open Space, Recreation, Floodplain Protection, Farmland & Historic Preservation Trust Fund ("County Trust Fund"), provides matching grants to municipal governments and to nonprofit organizations for assistance in the development or redevelopment of outdoor municipal recreation facilities; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough of Leonia desires to further the public interest by obtaining a matching grant of \$95,000 from the County Trust Fund to fund the following project: Dudley Allen Park Improvements; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Borough Council of Leonia have reviewed the County Trust Fund Program Statement, and the Trust Fund Municipal Program Park Improvement application and instructions, and desires to make an application for such a matching grant and provide application information and furnish such documents as may be required; and,

WHEREAS, as part of the application process, the Mayor and Borough Council of Leonia held the required Public Hearing to receive public comments on the proposed park improvements in the application on May 15, 2023; and,

WHEREAS, the County of Bergen shall determine whether the application is complete and in conformance with the scope and intent of the County Trust Fund; and,

WHEREAS, the applicant is willing to use the County Trust Fund in accordance with such rules, regulations and applicable statutes, and is willing to enter into an agreement with the County of Bergen for the above-named project and ensure its completion on or about the project contract expiration date.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Leonia, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey:
