ORDINANCE NO. 2023-18

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A SPECIAL EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53(a) FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE PREPARATION OF A REVISED AND UPDATED APPROVED DIGITAL TAX MAP OF THE BOROUGH OF LEONIA, COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY)

WHEREAS, the Borough of Leonia, County of Bergen, New Jersey ("Borough") desires to prepare a revised and updated approved tax map, which was last done in 2007; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Local Budget Law (*N.J.S.A.* 40A:4-1 et seq.) ("Local Budget Law") and, in particular, Section 53(a) thereof (*N.J.S.A.* 40A:4-53(a)), permits local units, including the Borough, to adopt ordinances authorizing special emergency appropriations to fund the costs of such preparation of an approved tax map; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has determined to fund the costs of a revised and updated approved tax map through the creation of a special emergency appropriation pursuant to and in accordance with the Local Budget Law; and

WHEREAS, the amount to be appropriated by the Borough for the purposes described above is \$50,000; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Borough Council to adopt this ordinance to create said special emergency appropriation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Leonia, County of Bergen, New Jersey (by not less than two-thirds of all the members thereof affirmatively concurring), pursuant to the provisions of the Local Budget Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-1 et seq., as amended and supplemented ("Local Budget Law"), as follows:

Section 1. The sum of \$50,000 is hereby appropriated for the payment of the preparation of a revised and updated approved tax map, pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 40A:4-53(a).

<u>Section 2</u>. The appropriation shall be deemed a special emergency appropriation as defined and provided for in *N.J.S.A.* 40A:4-53 and 40A:4-55.

Section 3. The Borough may fund said special emergency appropriation either from surplus or through the issuance of "Special Emergency Notes" in accordance with the provisions of *N.J.S.A.* 40A:4-55.

A. Where such appropriation is financed from surplus funds available, at least 1/5 of the amount thereof shall be included in each annual budget until the appropriation has been fully provided for.

B. Where such appropriation is financed through the issuance of "Special Emergency Notes" at least 1/5 of all such notes, and the renewals thereof, shall mature and be paid in each year, so that all notes and renewals shall have matured and have been paid not later than the last day of the fifth year following the date of the adoption of the emergency resolution authorizing the borrowing of such money and the issuance of the "Special Emergency Notes."

<u>Section 4</u>. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication, or as soon thereafter as may be otherwise required by law. A copy of this ordinance shall be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services upon adoption.

2022 AUDIT REVIEW

WHEREAS, R.S. 52:27BB-34 authorizes the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey to prescribe reports pertaining to the local fiscal affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Local Finance Board has promulgated N.J.A.C. 5:30-6.5, a regulation requiring that the governing body of each municipality shall by resolution certify to the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey that all members of the governing body have reviewed, as a minimum, the sections of the annual audit entitled "Comments and Recommendations", and;

WHEREAS, the members of the governing body have personally reviewed as a minimum the Annual Report of Audit, and specifically the sections of the Annual Audit entitled "comments and Recommendations", as evidenced by the group affidavit form of the governing body attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, such resolution of certification shall be adopted by the Governing Body no later than forty-five days after the receipt of the annual audit, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:30-6.5; and

WHEREAS, all members of the governing body have received and have familiarized themselves with, at least, the minimum requirements of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey, as stated aforesaid, and have subscribed to the affidavit, as provided by the Local Finance Board; and

WHEREAS, failure to comply with the regulations of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey may subject the members of the local governing body to the penalty provisions of R.S. 52:27BB-52, to wit:

R.S. 52:27BB-52: A local officer or member of a local governing body who, after a date fixed for compliance, fails or refuses to obey an order of the director (Director of Local Government Services), under the provisions of this Article, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, may be fined not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisoned for not more than one year, or both, in addition shall forfeit his office.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Leonia, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey hereby states that it has complied with N.J.A.C. 5:30-6.5 and does hereby submit a certified copy of this resolution and the required affidavit to said Board to show evidence of said compliance.

2022 Audit Corrective Action Plan

Finding 01

Old escrow deposits continue to be reviewed and cleared of record, where applicable.

Corrective Action: The CFO and appropriate personnel will review and clear old escrow deposits where applicable.

Finding 02

All interfunds be cleared of record on a periodic basis and as of December 31 and all budgeted interfund transactions be transacted during the calendar year.

Corrective Action: The CFO and newly appointed financial consultant will review and take action, if needed, on any current interfunds.

Finding 03

The inactive reserves in the Current and Other Trust Funds be reviewed and cleared of record.

Corrective Action: The CFO will conduct a review of inactive reserves with administration and recommend to the governing body which applicable reserves can be cleared of record.

Finding 04

Old outstanding grant receivables and grant reserves be reviewed and cleared of record.

Corrective Action: The CFO will conduct a review of grant receivables and inactive grant reserves with the finance staff and administration prior to recommending to the governing body which applicable grant receivables and reserves can be cleared of record.

Finding 05

The Chief Financial Officer did not properly maintain the books of original entry and general ledgers for the calendar year 2022.

Corrective Action: The CFO and Finance staff will maintain the books of original entry and general ledger moving forward in addition to timely reconciling all general ledger balances to subsidiary records and bank reconciliations.

Finding 06

The Borough should not incur any expenditure for which no appropriation exists or in excess of the amount appropriated for such purpose.

Corrective Action: The Borough has adopted a purchasing manual and distributed it to all department heads in 2023. Additionally, the CFO and Administrator have re-worked internal controls so that Department Heads are the first line of the purchasing process rests with the Department Head. Additional internal controls are now also in effect that do not allow departments from over expending their respective budget.

Finding 07

Purchase orders be approved prior to the receipt of goods and/or services.

Corrective Action: The CFO has reviewed the internal controls for purchasing with the Purchasing Agent and Borough Administrator and re-worked internal controls so that Department Heads are the first line of the purchasing process rests with the Department Head. Training will continue to be ongoing with staff to assure that purchases are made in accordance with both the purchasing law (NJSA 40A:11) and the Borough's Purchasing Policy.
