ORDINANCE NO. 2024-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 267 "TOWING", SECTION 267-6 "TOWING, WINCHING AND STORAGE FEES" OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF LEONIA

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Leonia believe it is in the best interests of the Borough to amend the Towing Ordinance.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Leonia, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1.

Chapter 267 "Towing", Section 267-6 "Towing, Winching and Storage Fees" of the Code of the Borough of Leonia is amended and supplemented in its entirety as follows:

§267-6 Towing, Winching and Storage Fees

Towing, winching and storage fees shall be the current maximum rates as established by the New Jersey State Police - https://www.nj.gov/njsp/information/towing-rates-application.shtml. Such rates shall be deemed to be renewed on a yearly basis to the rates established by the New Jersey State Police.

The current rates are those in effect for the calendar year 2023 and are as follows:

Towing - Basic:

AUTHORIZE PAYMENT OF OMNIA TIERED NETWORK HEALTH INSURANCE SELECTION INCENTIVES

WHEREAS, the Borough of Leonia participates in the State Health Benefit Plan (SHBP) to provide medical/health insurance to its employees; and

If a subscriber voluntarily retires or changes health plans due to a catastrophic or emergency health need as determined by the employer within the year, then the incentive shall be forfeited on a pro-rata basis.
